Dear Léon Jansen,

The Minister of Infrastructure and Watermanagement announced another package on May 24th.

June 21 we shared our point of view ("Zienswijze") in the Balanced Approach Procedure.

Let me highlight one of the proposals of The Hague, as it is symbolic for the past two years, where the Ministry and Minister refused to listen and consult the industry partners. A dialogue is the minimum one could expect, right?

The Minister proposes to close 2 of the 5 runways between 13.00-15.00 hours. Another proposal not discussed, but just launched like a loose cannon. To come to a sensible, workable proposal two important parties should have been consulted and asked for their input. LVNL, Air Traffic Control the

Netherlands and Amsterdam Airport Schiphol. However, both have been neglected, not consulted, not asked for their input and advise. There was no prior technical cooperation with LVNL. Any reduction in the use of secondary runways must be carefully coordinated with LVNL, and requires technical cooperation between airport operators, aircraft operators and air navigation service providers. The selection of the peak time for airlines where there are very few available slots on primary runways was decided by the Ministry without any consultation. This measure will also lead to a greater use of primary runways without increasing the capacity of these runways, which will result in delays and other operational inefficiencies, including cancellation of flights, leading to an irreversible negative effect on network connectivity. Both, LVNL & Schiphol now confirm that the closure of two runways can't be done in a safe and responsible way. Until today the Ministry of I&W and its Minister are driving too fast, feet on the gas, crashing left and right and neglecting all important signals. It's time for a change!

However, since a new Minister will commence shortly and the EC will start their Summer recess as per 01 August, it is not likely that a submission by the Ministry of I&W is imminent.
